Articles of Incorporation Requirements

Cooperatives Act

This document does not apply to extra-provincial cooperatives registering under the *Cooperatives Act*.

The Articles of Incorporation is a document developed by the cooperative that provides information required by the Act and Cooperatives Regulation. Articles of Incorporation must be submitted when a cooperative continues or incorporates.

To help prepare your Articles the following checklist provides information about what must be and what may be included in the Articles. This also includes additional requirements for housing, multi-stakeholder, employment, and new generation cooperatives.
