DIRECTOR'S ORDER UNDER SECTION 157 OF THE FAIR TRADING ACT TO BLUE EAGLE RECRUITMENT CONSULTANT, INC.

AND TO
PERFECT OPTIONS INC.
AND TO
JASEN ITEN

ISSUES

Jasen Iten is the President of Blue Eagle Recruitment Consultant, Inc. and Perfect Options Inc., employment agencies located in Taiwan.

Service Alberta has investigated allegations related to employment agency activities engaged in by Blue Eagle Recruitment Consultant, Inc. and Jasen Iten on behalf of COR International Placement Ltd. and found evidence that:

- 1. Blue Eagle Recruitment Consultant, Inc. and Jasen Iten acted as agents of COR International Placement Ltd. and Nu-Options Recruiting Corporation, both licensed employment agencies in Alberta.
- 2. Blue Eagle Recruitment Consultant, Inc. and Jasen Iten demanded and collected fees from individuals seeking employment in Alberta at the request of COR International Placement Ltd. and Nu-Options Recruiting Corporation.

Based on these findings, the Director has formed the opinion that Blue Eagle Recruitment Consultant, Inc., Perfect Options Inc., and Jasen Iten have breached the Fair Trading Act.

LEGISLATION

The Employment Agency Business Licensing Regulation AR 189/99 states:

Section 9:

- (1) No business operator may directly or indirectly demand or collect a fee, reward or other compensation
 - a. From a person who is seeking
 - i. Employment, or
 - ii. Information respecting employers seeking employees

or

- b. From a person
 - i. For securing or endeavoring to secure employment for the person, or
 - ii. For providing the person with information respecting any employer seeking an employee.

Alberta

ORDER

Blue Eagle Recruitment Consultant, Inc., Perfect Options Inc. and Jasen Iten individually or through any employee, representative, agent or associate, must immediately stop demanding or indirectly demanding or collecting a fee, reward or other compensation from a person who is seeking employment in Alberta, or from a person for securing or endeavoring to secure employment for the person in Alberta.

NON-COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER

ANY PERSON WHO FAILS TO COMPLY WITH AN ORDER OF THE DIRECTOR UNDER SECTION 157 OF THE FAIR TRADING ACT CONTRAVENES THIS ACT AND IS GUILTY OF AN OFFENCE AND MAY BE PROSECUTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 163 OF THE FAIR TRADING ACT.
