DIRECTOR'S ORDER UNDER SECTION 157 OF THE FAIR TRADING ACT

TO

CITADEL IMPROVEMENT AND PATIO LTD (CITADEL)

AND TO

ROBERT (BOB) ERIC HANSON (HANSON)

AND TO

ANY EMPLOYEE, REPRESENTATIVE OR AGENT OF CITADEL

Issues

- Consumers have indicated that Citadel has not completed home renovation work on prepaid contracts and failed to provide refunds on cancelled contracts. Investigations regarding these issues are continuing.
- Citadel is unlikely to be in a position to perform any new contracts.
- This Director's Order is separate from any future enforcement action that may result from the investigations.

Order


Citadel, Hanson, any employee, representative or agent (supplier) must:

- Within 15 days of the date of this order provide to the Director, as delegated under the Fair Trading Act, an increase to the security to \$75,000 from \$25,000. The security increase can be done by way of endorsement increasing the security bond or, an irrevocable letter of credit or, the cash security agreement.
- Immediately cease engaging in the activities of a prepaid contracting business by soliciting, negotiating or concluding any **new** home renovation contracts until that security increase is in effect.

The supplier may complete work on existing contracts.

NON-COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER

- **ANY PERSON WHO FAILS TO COMPLY WITH AN ORDER OF THE DIRECTOR UNDER SECTION 157 OF THE FAIR TRADING ACT CONTRAVENES THIS ACT AND IS GUILTY OF AN OFFENCE AND MAY BE PROSECUTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 163 OF THE FAIR TRADING ACT.**
