DIRECTOR'S ORDER UNDER SECTION 157 OF THE FAIR TRADING ACT

BACKGROUND AND ISSUES

From August 20 until August 23, 2013, Consumer Services, Investigation Services South, undertook a proactive investigation initiative to determine whether contractors are operating as prepaid contracting businesses in Alberta without a licence. The goal of this operation was to ensure awareness of and compliance with the licensing and contract requirement regime for prepaid contracting businesses. The Prepaid Contracting Business Licensing Regulation gives consumers assurance that money they give to a contractor is protected through security in place for that purpose, and the contractor is following legislated requirements. By conducting this operation, Consumer Services can help ensure a safe and fair marketplace for both consumers and prepaid contracting businesses.

Vaughn Hunt, operating as Shingle King Roofing, was a target of the proactive investigative initiative and attended a residential home in Calgary, Alberta where a contract was negotiated for a home renovation project. At the home, Vaughn Hunt, discussed the amount of prepayment required before work commenced.

It is believed that with the evidence obtained in this undercover operation, that Vaughn Hunt has breached sections of the *Fair Trading Act* and the Prepaid Contracting Business Regulation.

The activity of soliciting, negotiating or concluding a prepaid contract in person, in a location other than their normal place of business and accepting a deposit or prepayment prior to completion of the project constitutes a "**Prepaid Contracting Business**". This requires Vaughn Hunt to be licensed as required under Section 104(1) of the *Fair Trading Act*.

A "Prepaid Contracting Business" means the activities of soliciting, negotiating or concluding in person, at any place other than the seller's place of business, a prepaid contract.

A "Prepaid Contract" means a construction or maintenance contract in which all or part of the contract price is to be paid before all of the goods or services called for in the contract are provided.


A "Construction or Maintenance Contract" in part means a contract for the purposes of constructing, altering, maintaining, repairing, adding to or improving a person's own private dwelling or a structure/building located on the same property, used in conjunction with the person's own private dwelling or improving real estate property to be used in connection with the person's own private dwelling/building/structure.

ORDER

Vaughn Hunt, operating as Shingle King Roofing, individually or through any employee, representative, agent, or associate must immediately stop engaging in the activities of a "Prepaid Contracting Business" by soliciting, negotiating, or concluding in person, at any place other than the seller's place of business, a prepaid contract.

NON COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER

ANY PERSON WHO FAILS TO COMPLY WITH AN ORDER OF THE DIRECTOR UNDER SECTION 157 OF THE *FAIR TRADING ACT* CONTRAVENES THIS ACT AND IS GUILTY OF AN OFFENCE AND MAY BE PROSECUTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 163 OF THE *FAIR TRADING ACT*.
